Backtest Wizard™ 3.0 now imports historical stock data and volatilities directly from the web into for quicker, easier analysis.

An integrated worksheet in Option Wizard™ Online, Backtest Wizard™ 3.0 takes the last 200 days of high-low-close and volume, analyzes for volume, trend and momentum and returns buy and sell signals. All indicators and signals may be customized. Data source is Microsoft Investor Network; (Option Wizard is a member of Microsoft's Software Developer Network.)

Backtest Wizard provides an ideal environment for paper trading.

Similarly, Option Wizard™ Online imports implied volatility, and 20, 50 and 100 day historical volatilities for all stocks and indices to determine the fair value option price. Data source is McMillan Analysis Corporation.

There is no data charge at this time for either service.

Option Wizard 7.3 (offline) clients may upgrade to the streamlined online (delay) version for \$59.95. Upgrade clients will also receive notes from the Blue Page Publishing Options Seminar, April, 1999 held in Anaheim, California.

The new Backtest Wizard 3.0 price is \$199.95; \$49.95 when purchased with any Option Wizard product (offline, delay or real time). Powered by PC Quote, Option Wizard Online is \$299.95 (delay) and \$499.95 (real time). Delay data is free; real time is \$9.95 per month plus exchange fees. A trial version of Option Wizard Online is available for \$59.95.

Option Wizard debuted on the worldwide web in August, 1995, and quickly won a worldwide audience of adherents who wish to do options analytics and technical analysis in a familiar and customizable Microsoft Excel environment. (Microsoft Excel is the program of choice among many top Wall Street institutional financial and options analysts because it can be customized.) Unique features include the decay table, percent-to-double, and Internet integration.

Option Wizard won a Reader's Choice Award in December, 1998 from *Technical Analysis of Stocks and Commodities* magazine.
